

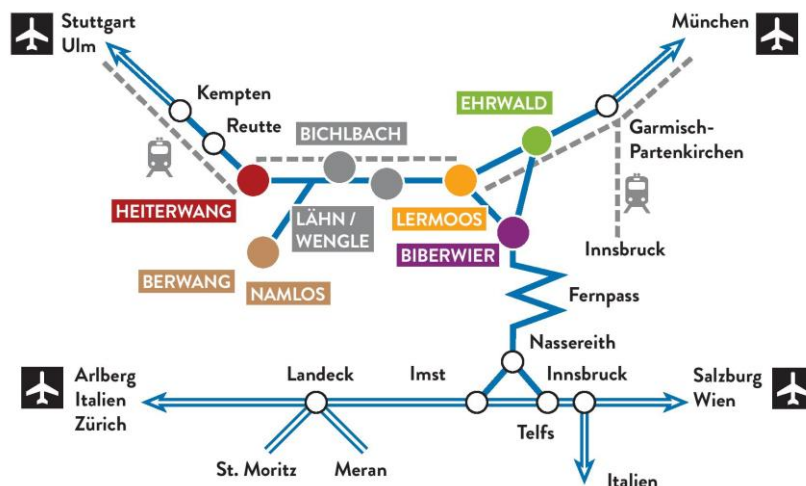
THE TIROLER ZUGSPITZ ARENA – AT A GLANCE

GENERAL The Tiroler Zugspitz Arena comprises the villages of Ehrwald, Lermoos, Berwang, Bichlbach, Biberwier, Heiterwang am See, Lähn-Wengle and Namlos.

LOCATION The Zugspitze, Germany's highest peak, marks the country's border with Austria. It is accessible from both the German and Austrian sides of the frontier. From Ehrwald the Tiroler Zugspitzbahn cable car serves the western summit of the Zugspitze.

The Tiroler Zugspitz Arena lies on the Austrian side of the Zugspitze in the Außerfern region of Tyrol, nestling between the Wetterstein Mountains with the Zugspitze to the north and the Mieminger range to the south.

ALTITUDE 994 m (Ehrwald) to 1,342 m (Berwang), and 2,962 m (Zugspitze)

ARRIVAL

By car from

- Innsbruck (75 km): From Innsbruck to Telfs, via Nassereith and the Fernpass to the Tiroler Zugspitz Arena
- Meran (180 km) or Zürich (260 km): Take the E 60/A12 to Imst, then travel via Nassereith and over the Fernpass
- Munich (110 km): Take the A 95 to Garmisch-Partenkirchen and cross the Austrian border in Griesen
- Stuttgart (250 km): Take the A 7 to Kempten and cross the Austrian border at Füssen. Then continue towards Reutte.

By train to Garmisch-Partenkirchen, from where it is easy to reach the Tiroler Zugspitz Arena. There are stations in Ehrwald, Lermoos, Lähn-Wengle, Bichlbach and Heiterwang am See.

By plane to Innsbruck (75 km), Munich (110 km) or Memmingen (100 km)

Z-Ticket

- Validity: three to thirteen days from 8 May to 7 November 2021
- Costs for three days: adults EUR 69, youths EUR 55, children EUR 34.50
- Costs for 13 days: adults EUR 144, youths EUR 115, children EUR 72

- From 8 May to 4 July 2021 and from 28 August to 7 November 2021 the Z-Ticket will be offered at a special reduced price if purchased for a minimum of six days.
- 17 leisure facilities included – e.g. cable car travel incl. ascent and descent with the Tiroler Zugspitzbahn, summer toboggan run, swimming pools, etc.
